His lines of research have focused on modified release systems, preparation of micro and nanoparticles, strategies to increase solubility and use of lipid excipients to increase bioavailability. Dr. Miranda has the the distinction of the Perfil Deseable (PRODEP) and is a member of the Sistema Nacional de Investigadores, Level I (SNI I) of the CONACYT.
